## Skyscraper Stories

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The worst part about all these buildings is going down and up, up and down.

Each row and column in a skyscrapers puzzle contains six buildings, each with a different height between one and six stories inclusive. Numbers on the outside of the grid tell how many skyscrapers in that row or column may be seen from the location of the number. (Skyscrapers can only be seen if there are no taller skyscrapers in the way.)
