

Kevin's Puzzle of the Week

Target Practice

There are a number of archers working together to defend this grid. Each one stands on a single white square. From there they can see all squares in straight lines up, down, left, and right, though they cannot see through black squares.

Archers defend their own square, as well as any they can see. No archer may stand in a black square or in a square targeted by another archer. Black squares with numbers tell how many archers are standing in one of the four squares right next to them. Every white square is defended by at least one archer.
