On Christmas Eve, Scrooge was visited by the ghosts who sailed the seven seas.

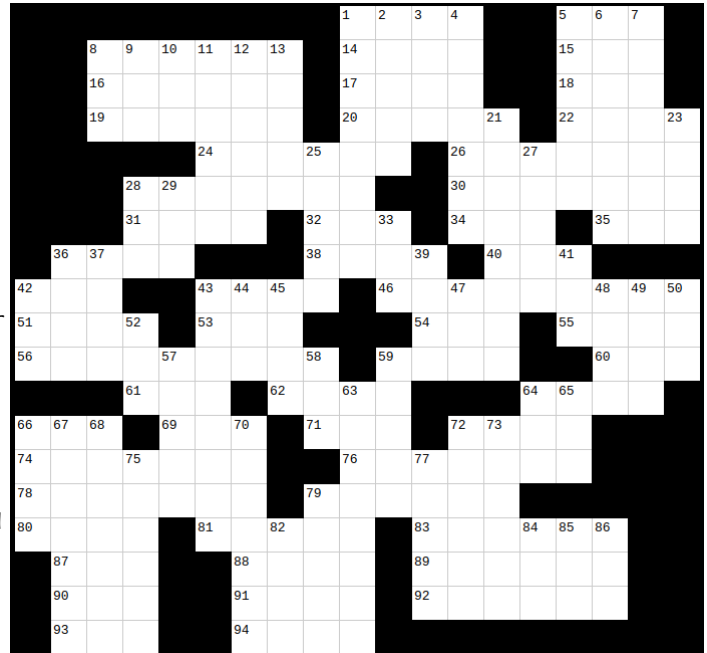
